	Title should be on a single line (no paragraphs) Length is 50-250 characters (including spaces) Do not use all capital letters and do not capitalise the first letter of each word Do not use any abbreviation in the title Do not put a period at the end of the title Title should not have each word capitalised

	Do not change the headings, the system will not allow you to upload a document with modified headings:
	In total, the ideal number of block characters (including spaces) should be between 500-2500
	The characters of the table are included in the count of the total number of characters used
	You do not need to enter content in all blocks
	Do not leave spaces between each blocks

- ☐ Main formatting rules:
 - o Define all abbreviations at first use
 - Decimal point should be a period (2.5)
 - Put spaces between signs and number (2.5 = a)
 - Significance value should be small 'p', not bolded nor italic (p > 2.5)
 - o Avoid using symbols (use "alpha", not α). Never use the "symbol" font

Abstracts that have previously been presented in non-EASL international
gastroenterology/hepatology meetings/journals will NOT be accepted. Please ensure that
your abstract has never been presented before. If this rule is not respected, the abstract will be rejected, and will not be considered.

Exception: Any abstract submitted for presentation at any **2019-2020 EASL event** (monothematic conferences, special conferences or summits) may also be submitted and will be considered for presentation at The International Liver Congress™ 2020.
